Agenda Items:

Approval of Last Meeting Minutes:

There was a motion to approve the minutes from our last meeting, 6/23/08. The motion was seconded and approved.

Bulky Waste Day:

- Roger will send out a report showing the results from BWD and we will discuss next time.
- Officer Gelinas suggested adding signs and cones to help control traffic during BWD. Cones could be added to move cars over closer to the side as they line up to bring in their trash. Signs that could be added include "Watch for Pedestrians", "BWD Right Lane Only", and "One Lane Traffic". We will probably need 2 officers to direct traffic at least during the first 2 hours. He also suggested that we could get lowboy trash haulers to make it easier and faster to load with trash. The lower height would enable the backhoe to compact the trash better. It would also be easier on the helpers as they unload the trash.
