SUBJECT: Formation of ad-hoc committee..

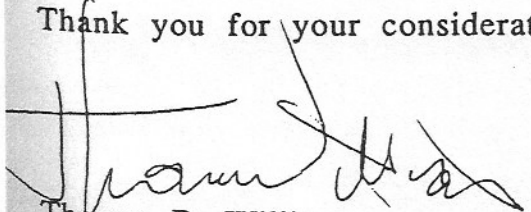
After meeting with Lake Association members and other concerned citizens, the Planning Board would like the Select Board to form an ad-hoc committee for the purpose of studying three items. The studies would result in making recommendations to the town on those items, including the creation of warrant articles if appropriate for town meeting consideration.

The three items to be studied are:

- 1) How can residents, especially seasonal residents in the Lake Wyola area, become better educated about the issues of proper sewage disposal,
- 2) How can the roads of the Lake Wyola area be improved for purposes of safety, runoff control, access, and maintenance (this could include the creation of a betterment district), and
- 3) How can the Lake Wyola area environment be best preserved, including tracking water quality and possible means for correcting sources of problems.

It was agreed that the committee would be best formed by having at least one member each from the Planning Board, Conservation Commission, and the Board of Health. We also feel that participation by a Select Board member would be beneficial. It is expected that the Lake Association will choose a minimum of three and a maximum of five members for the committee, and may also choose any additional property owners who might lend technical expertise. This committee could get started right away. I would like to suggest the name "Lake Wyola Planning Committee".
