#### 1. Introduction

To make our home handicapped accessible, we want to expand an existing deck, and enclose it, to create a mudroom with handicap accessible doorways and a screen porch, both of which have floors that are at the same level as the existing house.

#### 2. Site Description

The project site is a single-family house lot on the southwestern shore of Lake Wyola, between Lake Drive and Lake Wyola. The site slopes moderately down from the road to the shore. The house is surrounded by mown lawn and existing landscaped areas. There is an existing 5' to 10' vegetative, terraced buffer along the lake composed of primary high-bush Blueberry (Vaccinium corymbosum), Maleberry (Lyonia ligustrina), Mountain Laurel (Klamia Latifolia) and a variety of other native plants. The site has an existing walkway and stairway that accesses the water and dock respectively.

#### 3. Project Description

The project includes (see attached drawing):

- Hand removal of the existing stairway.
- Add 5' to the existing deck to create a 10' wide floor (see highlighted area). The
  existing concrete piles that support the stairway will be reused.
- Add 4 drilled helical piles.
- Enclose a 10' X 42' section of the deck with a combination mudroom and screen porch.

The project is in both the 100' and 50' Buffer Zone. The existing deck and addition are greater than 25' from the lake. No soil disruption is anticipated because no new concrete piers will be dug. Structural support will be provided using a combination of the existing concrete pilings and the addition of 4 drilled heliacal pilings. There will be no change in slope, no substantive soil disruption and no tree or large bush removal. The existing

terraced Goshen Stone patio and vegetated garden will remain in tack, except on small

Rhododendron will be moved to another location on the property.

The roof will add 210 ft<sup>2</sup> of impervious surface. Rainwater from the roof will be directed into

an existing dry well and over existing established lawn and garden.

4. Performance Standards:

The proposed work will be within the buffer zone of the Land Under Waterbody only.

Erosion controls (silt fence) will be in place prior to work commencing to protect against

the siltation of Lake Wyola.

5. Construction Sequence

Any Special Conditions in the Order of Condition pertaining to inspection of erosion control structures or preconstruction meetings will be followed. The contractor will then follow the

general sequence of work outlined below:

The Contractor will install sedimentation control in the form of a continuous silt

fence around the project site.

The Contractor will remove the existing stairway.

The helical piles will be drilled.

The mudroom and screen porch will be built.

Discarded construction materials will be removed from the site via dumpster.

6. Summary:

This NOI proposes no changes to the Land Under Waterbody being Lake Wyola, no grade

changes, no soil disruption, and no significant changes to vegetation.




Existing Conditions 5-1-2024
