- 4. POLE APP update: (If you remember I asked multiple people WGE, John Furey from MBI and utility represpentatives if we should include Service poles for drops on the applications. Everyone said yes) BUT Rick has been working with the utilities and got advice to REMOVE 285 service poles from the apps for Verizon willing to do this. Right off the bat it saved us over 2K in make ready work for this first app. Will make the others go faster. The problem is that there is no way to call out drop poles from your applications. All poles on an app are considered to have strand so the utility is considering all in need of make ready. This isn't right. Rick and Verizon say just hang your fiber then present a list to Verizon saying here are the poles you can now charge us rent for after the fact. No make –ready needed. AND should encourage everyone possible to do conduit if they can reduce maintenance costs and ongoing pole rental.
