## 2. Discuss status of Bid Docs. for SES

4. Discuss spreadsheet regarding supplying to Capital Planning and other Committees; i.e., photos and introductory letter

SD will send photos of the 5-7 additional items in the Future Capital Requests (8 total) to FM to add to the Spreadsheets. SD will also send a draft of an introductory letter to all Building Comm. members prior to the next meeting for review. This letter will accompany the Spreadsheets when sent to the Capital Planning Comm., the Finance Comm. and the Select Board.

## 5. Discuss leaking roof at Dam Keeper's

Becky Torres will get the roofing material, specifically the felt paper, tested for asbestos and will interface with the ConCom to determine if a Notice of Intent is required before we go forward with replacing the roof.

## 6. Unanticipated items

SD asked about the snow rake for the courtyard at the Shutesbury Elementary School; i.e., can one use the snow rake without needing to be on a ladder and a "super" snake for the long underground drain pipes. SS is still working on this.

In the past the installation of a water storage cistern has been floated as an idea at Shutesbury Elementary School. As a Future Capital request the BC may suggest combining School & Fire to have an engineered plan to redesign the drainage that would collect the water and incorporate more cleanouts in the drainage system.
