Building committee report: Progress has been made. The redesign is impressive. The overall cost of the project has been reduced and the revised schematic design has been finalized and sent to the cost estimator and we expect the new cost estimate the beginning of next week. Less site work has been proposed, closer to the road, it's a different type of construction (built more like a house) which will open up the number of contractors who will be able to bid on the project, the building is smaller. The good stuff has been maintained. 63,000 kilowatt hour solar array which will power the building.
