Library Trustees Meeting 10/21/2024

- 1. Minutes from August meeting: Reminder to include budget table as attachment when posting. Motion to accept minutes as amended. Elizabeth yes, Brad yes, Michele yes, Pam yes, Kate yes. Approved unanimously.
 - a. To do: review September minutes at October meeting.
- 2. Written director's report to be attached. Includes highlights on:
 - a. Good Neighbor Day
 - b. Two new computers have been purchased and installed (nine hours total work)
 - i. Will be useful to have these set up and running when we move into new library
 - ii. Trustees appreciated the funds from the Town IT budget
 - c. Multiple grant applications
 - i. Some are for work that will happen before we have a new library
 - ii. Some, we hope, will fund first few months of programming in new library
- 3. Discussion of budget request for FY '26
 - a. Change to Trustee Fund line
 - i. 20% of total budget has to be spent on new materials to qualify for state aid
 - ii. Need to include the 3% salary raise to total budget, which equals a \$500 increase in acquisition funding requirement
 - iii. Added \$500 to Trustee Fund line to ensure that we can qualify for state aid
 - iv. Once new building is complete, we can plan state aid funding to operating budget/future maintenance funds, etc.
 - b. Discussion of Trustee Fund and other revenue sources for newer Trustees
 - i. Clarified that if Trustees approve proposed budget, we will approve the appropriation from the fund
 - 1. Rev fund = e.g., payment at library for making copies.
 - 2. Dog tax = our share of the fees for registering dogs in town.
 - 3. LCC = Shutesbury Cultural Council.

- 4. Trustee Fund = fund remaining from the bequest of stock from Myron Spear. What remains in the fund is the interest from the principal. Principal has been directed to new library fund. A room in the new library will be named for Spear
- c. Motion to approve budget: Kate yes, Pam yes, Elizabeth yes, Brad yes, Michele yes. Approved unanimously.
- 4. Friends fundraisers (Elizabeth)
 - a. Turkey Trot on November 23. Consider volunteering to support. Cap of 250 runners. More sponsorships this year too.
 - b. Paver fundraiser, going on right now. Orders need to be in by end of January. Write three lines/30 characters on pavers for \$150 donation. Promotion underway.
 - i. For next meeting: discuss whether Trustees will donate one or more pavers
 - c. Soups and Stews-Dec 6th
 - d. Giving Tuesday- Dec 3rd
