## Open Space Committee Minutes – 12/18/2024 [approved 1/08/25] Virtual Meeting

Meeting was opened at 9:37 am.

- 1) The Subduing Knotweed Coalition is applying for a CPC grant to develop a townwide plan for managing knotweed. The plan would be developed by a professional and would provide a framework for controlling this invasive for the long term. The Coalition has requested that the Open Space Committee serve as sponsor for the project by co-signing their grant application.
  - a) Siefert presented a number of technical questions concerning the project's implementation and funding (see them <a href="here">here</a>). Jaques suggested these questions were appropriate to an eventual CPC project hearing but not to this OSC discussion of project support.
  - b) Question: In principle, does the OSC support development of a plan for knotweed mitigation?
    - i. Jaques moved, and Fleischaker seconded, that the OSC serve as sponsor for the Coalition's application for CPC grant.
    - ii. Vote: Jaques, Aye. Bigelow, Aye. Fleischaker, Aye. Motion passed unanimously.

  - a. Eight town plans are posted on line. Shutesbury's plan is still in draft form so not yet available online.
