

SMIC Minutes 7/1/26

Open meeting at 7:05 pm

Discussion focused on review of the GZA engineer priority areas for their infrastructure conceptual designs.

GZA originally offered 10 priority areas. The committee discussed adding one: Randall Road, (drainage area #4 on the *Lake Wyola Drainage Area Prioritization 6.25.26 map*).

Discussion about which of the already-identified 10 areas we would drop in order to include area #4. Use of the GZA PowerPoint, *Lake Wyola Watershed_6.25.pdf* chart titled “Drainage Area Prioritization” assisted in the discussion and we concluded that drainage area #11 had the lowest 100 yr peak outflow estimates and that it would be a good candidate.

Suggestion was made to approach GZA to see if they would agree to include 11 priority areas for designs (in order to accommodate #4) and if they were unable to, then to propose dropping #11.

Vote on this was a unanimous YES.

Agreement to meet again in August and Wallace to coordinate dates.
